DMTF's annual summer event – <u>2021 Alliance Partner Technical Symposium (APTS)</u> – was held via Zoom, July 26-30. While we certainly missed the face-to-face interaction that APTS affords us, the virtual event was still deemed a success.

Led by DMTF's Vice President of Alliances, John Leung, the annual event featured collaborative working group meetings and focused on technical topics of interest to DMTF's Alliance Partners, as well as keynote addresses from PCI Industrial Computer Manufacturer Group (PICMG), Storage Networking Industry Alliance (SNIA), and OpenFabrics Alliance (OFA).

- Toward Industry 4.0 PICMG standardization efforts for Industrial IoT Presented by Doug Sandy of PCI Industrial Computer Manufacturer Group (PICMG).
 - This presentation provided an update of PICMG's Industrial IoT standardization efforts. PICMG's efforts leverage DMTF specifications to enable new applications in industrial automation and control.
- Evolving SNIA and Storage Standards to Match Shifting Industry Trends Presented by Richelle Ahlvers of the Storage Networking Industry Association (SNIA).
 - The storage landscape is shifting, and with it, manageability challenges. In this presentation, Richelle covered some of the shifting trends in the storage market and how the SNIA is evolving to track these changes. Attendees learned about how SNIA's shift to a focus on key pillars of functionality including manageability, security, and increasing partnerships and alliances with other organizations, including not only the DMTF, but other organizations jointly, are helping the organization to adapt.
- OpenFabrics Alliance (OFA) Mission, Purpose, and Partnerships Presented by Phil Cayton (OFA Vice-Chair).
 - Recently the OFA has expanded its partnership with DMTF, SNIA, and GEN-Z to build on the strengths of multiple organizations for the benefit of the ecosystem; this talk discussed the mission of the OFA, its current initiatives, and its partnerships with industry associations to advance the state of the ecosystem.

As part of DMTF's Alliance Partner program, the organization and the OpenFabrics Alliance (OFA) have agreed to a new work register, which outlines areas of technical collaboration between the two organizations.

The outcome of the alliance is to release a Redfish update that includes model extensions for managing a variety of fabrics as well as enable OFA to demonstrate a working OpenFabric Management Framework (OFMF) prototype utilizing the Redfish standard.
